



## SCOUTS HARBOURSIDE HIKEATHON 2008

### Sunday November 2nd

**Celebrate our Centenary and raise some funds at the same time.**

**WHAT IS IT?** The Scouts Harbourside Hikeathon is an opportunity for you to participate in a Scout activity, while raising funds for your Scout Group. Scouts can get sponsored or just come along for a great day out! The four Mosman area Scout groups are organising the Hikeathon as a combined activity and your Group can take part too.

**WHEN IS IT? SUNDAY NOVEMBER 2nd 2008**

**WHERE IS IT?** Venturers and Scouts hike from Manly, to the Spit and Freeston Hall, then to Balmoral, around Middlehead, past the Zoo to THE BARN in Mosman Bay (20 km). Cubs join the hikeathon at Freeston Hall (10 km). Joeys can take part too from Bradleys Head to the Barn (3.5 km). The start time and place for your Pack/Troop will be advised by the event organisers. All hiking teams finish at THE BARN, Mosman Bay from 3.30pm. A free sausage sizzle is provided for all Scouts who participate.

**HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?** A registration fee of \$10 per person for Scouts, and \$5 for Cubs/ Joeys goes toward Council permits and other fees. Sponsorship monies Scouts collect go to their Group! We raised \$2,000 last year.
