



## HOW TO COMPLETE THE GREY WOLF AWARD

**So you think you are Grey Wolf material do you?! To earn the highest award in the Cub Scout Section, you must have done all of the following things:**



### 1. Hold the Gold Boomerang

If you have been a great Cub Scout and you have attended everything that you possibly could, then you will get the Gold Boomerang easily.

### 2. In the past **12 months**, have participated in **4** outdoor activities

- One of which **must** be an overnight camp
- One of which should be an inter-Pack activity  
(Cubs from other Packs were there)
- One other outdoor activity  
(fun day, wide game, canoeing trip)
- One of which should be your bush walk:



*Using a map, plan and lead a bushwalk of at least 2 hours duration with your Leader and a group of Cub Scouts (at least 3, no more than 6). Make sure everyone has appropriate equipment, clothing, food and a personal first aid kit for your chosen bushwalk.*

This means that **you** have to organise your Six to go on the walk. **You** will have to make a list of the things they should bring and check they have them before you start. **You** will have to use a map to decide where you will walk. **You** will have to be the leader on the walk, making the decisions on which path to take, when to stop for a rest, reading the map, using the compass.

There are lots of things that can help you with this. Ask for copies of the following Fact Sheets that might be useful to you:

- What to take on a bushwalk
- Planning a walking route
- Leading a bushwalk

**You** will need to talk to your leader and parents about the best time to do this.

### 3. In the past **12 months** have attended **2** Pack Councils

A Pack Council is when the leaders and older members of the Pack (usually the Sixers) get together to talk about all the things happening in the Pack. It is your chance to make things better – say what you like, don't like, would like to try, etc. There should be one meeting per term which might be a special night, a few minutes during a meeting or some time at camp. You will need to ask a leader to hold a Pack Council for you if you have not finished this part.

**4. Have completed 4 level 2 achievement badges, one from each of the badge categories.** Level 2 badges have a maroon border. The four categories are displayed on the back of this card. If you are missing a category, then you will have to choose the one you would like to do and ask a leader for the details of what you need to do.
